Born 17 February 1754 at Saint-Martin (Île de Ré)

Commander of the expedition with the rank of Post Captain

Captain of the *Géographe*

Age on departure from Le Havre: 46

Died at the Île de France (Mauritius) on 16 September 1803 from tuberculosis
