

Stanislas Levillain

Born 1774 in Le Havre (Seine Maritime)

Had previously accompanied Baudin on his voyage to the West Indies on the *Belle-Angélique* (1796-1798)

Assistant zoologist on board the *Géographe*

Transferred to the *Naturaliste* at the Île de France (Mauritius) on 22 April 1801

Age on departure from Le Havre: 26

Died at sea on 23 December 1801, shortly after departure from Timor, from the effects of dysentery and fever contracted during the stopover there
