Merlot

Born 1786 and listed as coming from "Africa"

Assistant gardener on board the *Naturaliste* in the service of André Michaux, who had bought him in the Unitied States, where Merlot was a slave

Left the expedition at the Île de France (Mauritius) on 20 April 1801 and subsequently became the gardener of Zacavola, the king of the north-east coastal region of Madagascar, before being sold again as a slave following the killing of Zacavola in an uprising

Age on departure from Le Havre: 14

Date and place of death unknown
