Jacques de Saint-Cricq

Born 22 April 1781 in Lescard near Pau (Pyrénées-Atlantiques)

Sub-lieutenant on board the Naturaliste

Made acting lieutenant at Timor on 20 October 1801

Age on departure from Le Havre: 19

His subsequent career in the navy was far from glorious: a council of war held on 18 March 1812 declared him guilty of disobeying his commander's orders while in command of the frigate *La Clorinde*. He was declared unworthy of service and condemned to three years in detention.

Died in Carcassonne (Aude) on 19 March 1819
